SUBJECT: ANNUAL CHANGES TO THE CCDP HOUSEHOLD SIZE AND MONTHLY INCOME LIMITS

Every year, the federal government publishes the income figure which establishes Nevada's median income. A percentage of this figure is used to determine a household's eligibility and subsidy level for child care benefits.

The CCDP Household Size and Monthly Income Chart contains updated income limits and reflects subsidy eligibility at 85% of the State Median Income. The subsidy payment will be paid to the provider at the state maximum rate.

The income limits on this chart are effective October 1, 2023. The Nevada Child Care System (NCCS) was updated to ensure the correct subsidy level is applied to all new applications and ongoing certificates. Mass change was automated within NCCS and completed on September 6, 2023.

The CCDP Policy Manual will be updated to reflect this change with the next manual release.

•The Family Copayment Contribution (e.g., client copay) is based on gross income and household size. It is required from families with the exception of NEON, Foster/CPS, Wraparound, homeless households, Public/civil servants essential to Nevada's economic recovery, Individuals attending an approved substance use disorder (SUD) treatment or recovery program through the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health, and jobless due to COVID-19 (temporary basis) who may have their co-payment waived and subsidy paid at 100%.
