SUBJECT: PROVIDERS CAN BILL AND BE PAID FOR STATE HOLIDAYS

Effective January 1, 2025, providers can bill for state observed holidays when they occur on a day the center would normally be open. The center must be closed due to the holiday and the day must be included in the child's regular approved schedule. These are not considered discretionary days and should be coded with an "H" for Holiday on the timesheet. If the provider is open on the holiday, and a child does not attend, a discretionary day may be used. If a child utilizes more than one provider, only one provider can be paid for the holiday.
