

Except as set forth in (low-income section), a parent's "Base support obligation" means the dollar amount determined according to the following schedule:

(1) For one child, the sum of

- a. 16 percent of a parent's gross monthly income less than or equal to \$6000, plus
- b. 8 percent of a parent's gross monthly income from \$6001 to \$10000, plus
- c. 4 percent of a parent's gross monthly income in excess of \$10000.

(2) For two children, the sum of

- a. 22 percent of a parent's gross monthly income less than or equal to \$6000, plus
- b. 11 percent of a parent's gross monthly income from \$6001 to \$10000, plus
- c. 6 percent of a parent's gross monthly income in excess of \$10000.

(3) For three children, the sum of

- a. 26 percent of a parent's gross monthly income less than or equal to \$6000, plus
- b. 13 percent of a parent's gross monthly income from \$6001 to \$10000, plus
- c. 6 percent of a parent's gross monthly income in excess of \$10000.

(4) For four children, the sum of

- a. 28 percent of a parent's gross monthly income less than or equal to \$6000, plus
- b. 14 percent of a parent's gross monthly income from \$6001 to \$10000, plus
- c. 7 percent of a parent's gross monthly income in excess of \$10000.

(5) For each child in excess of 4 children, the sum of

- a. An additional 2 percent of a parent's gross monthly income less than or equal to \$6000,
plus
- b. An additional 1 percent of a parent's gross monthly income from \$6001 to \$10000,
plus
- c. An additional 0.5 percent of a parent's gross monthly income in excess of \$10000.
